## **Touch-typing Courses**

Students with literacy difficulties may struggle to write legibly and at speed. Learning to touch type has many benefits including:

- Supporting creativity and productivity: the student can focus on ideas rather than the mechanics of writing and spelling.
- Improving spelling and editing skills: it gives access to a spell checker, autocorrect, grammar checkers, text-to-speech.
- **Developing sound-letter links**: some programmes use a multisensory approach that develops letter-sound association.
- Helping to overcome fine motor difficulties: it helps students to produce neater work, which raises their self-esteem.
